USO Puget Sound Chosen as "Charity of the Month" by Bonneville Seattle

SEATTLE – The USO Puget Sound Area (USOPSA) has been chosen by Bonneville Seattle as the company's local "Charity of the Month" for October. Bonneville, the parent company of Seattle radio stations 710 KIRO, 770 KTTH The Truth, and B97.3 FM, plans to highlight the nonprofit work of the USO through promotional efforts on the company's radio stations and web sites as part of their new community involvement efforts.

Tom Hinman, USOPSA President and Executive Director, said that "being selected as 'Charity of the Month' was especially meaningful since it was the Bonneville employees that wanted to recognize the work of the USO." "This is a hands-on effort by Bonneville locally," added Hinman, "they see the burdens carried by military families, and appreciate the service and sacrifice being offered by our men and women in uniform. Bonneville is providing a huge boost of support to our volunteer efforts and we are truly grateful."

Cathy Cangiano, Director of Marketing, Bonneville Seattle, said that the company has launched a new community outreach effort that engages employees at many levels. "Our company values people and community and we've set up an employee outreach panel to partner with local charities," said Cangiano, "Bonneville chose the USO Puget Sound Area as our first 'Charity of the Month,' because the USO Puget Sound Area clearly encompasses the same values as we do.
