Funds will also help support USOPSA centers at Sea-Tac Airport and Joint Base Lewis-McChord, the USOPSA Mobile Canteen and programs such as United Through Reading, which allows deploying service members to record and send home books and video of themselves reading books to children and family back home.

The USOPSA 2011 Gala and Auction included a pre-Gala VIP event and meet and greet with Gala Celebrity Co-Chairs MLB Pitcher Jamie Moyer and Karen Moyer of The Moyer Foundation, a silent and live auction, and entertainment from renowned Bob Hope impersonator Bill Johnson.
