USO Puget Sound Area Receives \$50,000 Grant from Walmart Foundation

SEATTLE Dec. 29, 2010 – The USO Puget Sound Area (USOPSA) today announced a \$50,000 grant from the Walmart Foundation's Washington State Giving Program. The grant will help fund the continued operation of USO centers at Sea-Tac Airport and Joint Base Lewis-McChord, as well as events and community programs reaching nearly half a million military personnel and their families around the Puget Sound each year.
